

8. Specific preferences of the school/school district should be acknowledged by recruiters.
 - a. All recruiters should meet with any interested student during the activity period (7:55 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.). Forty-eight (48) hours notice is required.
 - b. Recruiters are permitted to set up a table during the eleventh and twelfth graders' lunch period (12:18 p.m. – 12:48 p.m.) once per semester. Additional visits must be approved by the principal or the principal's appointed representative (e.g. – guidance counselor). A forty-eight (48) hours notice is required in order for approval to be received.

ALL PROVISIONS STATED IN THE POLICY ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH PUBLIC LAW 107-110, NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND ACT OF 2001, SECTION 9525.

WORKER'S PERMIT

Worker's Permit applications are available in the guidance office for those students who have secured a job during the summer or after school. A birth certificate must be presented to the guidance counselor/designee to begin the application process. **STUDENT MUST BE OFFERED A JOB BEFORE APPLICATION CAN BE COMPLETED.**

- Ages 13-15 (vacation certificate, good for only 1 job)
- Ages 16-17 (transferable certificate in lieu of vacation)
- Age 18 or over (does not require a worker's permit)
